Dear Praying Friends,


It is a blessing to be able to daily serve our Lord and King. This is something we do not take lightly. It is a privilege, but also a responsibility to labor for the Kingdom.

On occasion they have the opportunity to learn household skills as well. Recently, Russell's mom was here visiting us and taught the girls how to make cranberry bread and lemon meringue pie. It was fun for them to make something different in the kitchen.







Russell continues to oversee the church's Bible Institute program. They are currently half way through the second part of Doctrines. Each week we have seen about 25 men and women from our church and a couple of other churches faithfully come for 2 hours to receive this training.
