Please pray that God will continue to bless the students and teachers as we continue offering courses.

The last week of March, Russell and Debbie traveled to the state of Veracruz where Russell taught a seminary module on Personal Finances. We were very encouraged by the response of these young people and the relationships we were able to form with them. We also got to see some close friends of many years while we were visiting.



Both Russell and Debbie are currently teaching night classes at the Christian University of the Americas. Debbie is teaching “Teaching English to Children” to the third year English Education majors, and Russell is teaching “Personal Finances” to all of the third and fourth year students. As the university goes until the beginning of July, please pray that we will all have strength to finish the year well. In June the university will be celebrating its 25th anniversary with a week of special events and concerts. We are thankful for God’s faithfulness to the school for all of these years.

Debbie has also continued her discipleship group on Monday evenings and her ladies’ group from church. Please pray for her continued recovery after breaking her arm in November. She is still in physical therapy, but because of slow progress, the doctor ordered an MRI to make sure there are no other issues. Later this week we will hopefully get the results.
